Please Join us for the Annual *Nyerges Nymph One-Fly Outing*

Start Time: 10:00 AM

Rules:

- ❖ Fish only with the Nyerges Nymph (your choice of size and color).
 - Flies must be approved by our official inspector. Those needing approved flies may obtain them at the inspector's station.
 - You may change colors/sizes during the fishing period.
- ❖ Bobbers, indicators, floats (regardless of size or material), electronic fish finders, electronic hook setting devices, depth sounders, GPS chart plotters and other accouterments are NOT allowed.
- ❖ Any angler observed adding garden hackle or scents to the fly will be suitably humiliated.
- ❖ One-Fly-Fishing will commence promptly at 10 AM and end promptly at 12 noon.
- ❖ Anglers may land any fish on the line when the noon whistle sounds.
- ❖ The angler landing the most fish shall be allowed bragging rights for the following year.

Nyerges Nymph

- Hook: #8-10 4XL
- Tail: Brown hackle fibers
- Body: Medium chenille (dark olive or as preferred)
- Hackle: Brown, tied palmer

Once tied, finish by clipping the top and both sides of the hackle fibers close to the body. This leaves the bottom fibers only, giving the appearance of a shrimp.
